BAD COMPANY REUNITED & PLAYING JULY 4TH !!!

After gathering for a one-off reunion last August, the surviving members of the original Bad Company - vocalist Paul Rodgers, guitarist Mick Ralphs and drummer Simon Kirke - are playing a 10-show mini-tour this Summer !!!

The East Coast trek kicked off 6/17/09 at the Seminole Hard Rock & Casino in Hollywood, FL. and marked the release of Bad Company's "Hard Rock Live" DVD, which was recorded at the same venue in August 2008. The DVD will be sold at this Summer's concert, then released to retail on 8/8/09. The tour ends on July 4th at Resorts Casino in Atlantic City, NJ !!!

Lynn Sorenson, the bassist from Rodgers' solo band, will step in for the late Boz Burrell, who passed away in 2006, while Howard Leese, best known from playing with Heart, who also works with Rodgers, will play second guitar. The Doobie Brothers will be opening all but the final show in Atlantic City.

This could be one of the last chances to see Bad Company play hits like, "Bad Company", "Shooting Star", "Movin' On", "Can't Get Enough", "Feel Like Makin' Love", "Rock 'n' Roll Fantasy", "Run With The Pack", "Ready For Love" and many more of their great songs that are all still in constant rotation on the radio !!!

The 2008 reunion date inspired Rodgers, Ralphs and Kirke to play some more concerts together. "It was a really good show, both the band and the fans were on fire," recalls singer Paul Rodgers in a recent interview, who broke away from his rehearsal schedule with Queen + Paul Rodgers to do that date. "Queen does fantastic versions of my material, but it was very authentic playing with the (Bad Company) guys, very much the real deal, I guess."

So, first Paul Rodgers is on a reunion mini-tour with his band-mates from Bad Company. Then, later this year it is rumored that he will tour again with Brian May and Roger Taylor under their incarnation of, Queen + Paul Rodgers in support of their 2008 album, "The Cosmos Rocks".

Lastly, Mick Ralphs, prior to joining Bad Company, was in Mott The Hoople, made famous by the song, "All The Young Dudes", which was written for them by David Bowie. That being said, there a lot of ties and connections between Bad Company, Paul Rodgers, Mick Ralphs, Mott The Hoople and Queen, as Queen was the support act for Mott The Hoople's 1974 tour of America. On that note, Mott The Hoople will be re-uniting for five concerts at the Hammersmith Apollo in London, in October 2009 (on the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th and 6th). The international record labels are asking Congress for a handout (H.R. 848 / S. 379) and they want to take it from local radio stations! Apparently, these big international record companies have a problem: they haven't adapted to the digital age. Now they are asking Congress to tax local radio stations to line their pockets and preserve a declining business - to the tune of billions of dollars!



The effects of a performance tax would be catastrophic, potentially forcing many radio stations out of business, causing additional job cuts in the radio industry, stifling airplay for artists, reducing the ability for radio stations to contribute to community organizations that rely on radio stations for support, and harming the listening public who depend on local radio right here in the Philadelphia tri-state area and across the country!

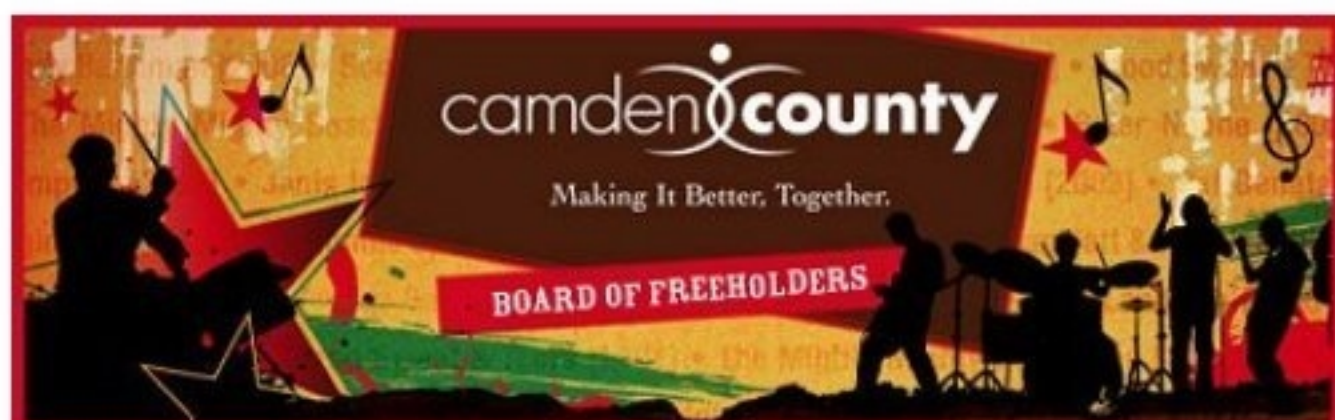

MICHAEL JACKSON DIES AT AGE 50 !!!

In our first edition it is sad to have this as our first Stage Page. So lets celebrate his life and his accomplishments because he was a musical genius.

Michael Jackson, the "King of Pop" who once moonwalked above the music world, died Thursday 6/25/09 at the age of 50 years old, as he prepared for a comeback tour, which he said during a press conference was his "Last Curtain Call".

Jackson died at the UCLA Medical Center after falling ill at his rented home in Holmby Hills. Paramedics tried to resuscitate him at his home for nearly three-quarters of an hour, then rushed him to the hospital, where doctors continued to work on him.

It is believed he suffered cardiac arrest in his home. However, the cause of his death will be unknown until results of the autopsy and toxicology reports are completed.

Jackson's death brought a tragic end to a long, bizarre, sometimes farcical decline from his peak in the 1980s, when he was popular music's premier all-around performer, a uniter of black and white music who shattered the race barrier on MTV, dominated the charts and dazzled even more on stage.

Michael Joseph Jackson was born August 29, 1958 and died July 25, 2009, at the all too young age of 50. He was 4 years old when he began singing with his brothers: Marlon, Jermaine, Jackie and Tito, in the Jackson 5. After his early success with bubblegum soul, he struck out on his own, generating innovative, explosive, unstoppable music.

His 1982 album "Thriller", which included the blockbuster hits, "Beat It," "Billie Jean" and "Thriller", is the best-selling album of all time, with an estimated 50 million copies sold worldwide. "Thriller" mixed the dark, serpentine bass and drums and synthesizer approach of "Billie Jean," the on "Wanna Be Startin' Somethin'."

At the time of his death, Jackson was rehearsing hard for what was to be his greatest comeback. He was scheduled for an unprecedented 50 shows at a London arena, with the first concert planned for 7/13/09.

As word of his death spread, MTV switched its programming to play videos from Jackson's heyday. Radio stations began playing marathons of his hits. Hundreds of people gathered outside the hospital. In New York's Times Square, a low groan went up in the crowd when a screen flashed that Jackson had died, and people began relaying the news to friends by cell phone. Many people thought and hoped it was a hoax, but it wasn't. The public first knew him as a boy in the late 1960s, when he was the precocious, spinning lead singer of the Jackson 5, the singing group he formed with his four older brothers, who were originally from Gary, Indiana. Among their No. 1 hits were "I Want You Back," "ABC" and "I'll Be There."

He was perhaps the most exciting performer of his generation, known for his backward-gliding moonwalk, his feverish, crotch-grabbing dance moves and his high-pitched singing, punctuated with squeals and titters. His single sequined glove, military-style jacket and aviator sunglasses were trademarks, as was his ever-changing, surgically altered appearance.

Jackson ranked alongside Elvis Presley and the Beatles as the biggest pop sensations of all time. He united two of music's biggest names when he was briefly married to Presley's daughter, Lisa Marie, and Jackson's death immediately evoked comparisons to that of Presley himself, who died at age 42 in 1977. Jackson married Lisa Marie Presley in 1994, and they divorced in 1996. Later that year, Jackson married Deborah Rowe, a former nurse for his dermatologist. They had two children together: Michael Joseph Jackson Jr., known as Prince Michael, and Paris Michael Katherine Jackson. Rowe filed for divorce in 1999.

As years went by, Jackson became an increasingly strange man. A middle-aged man-child weirdly out of touch with grown-up life. His skin became lighter due to an apparent genetic disorder (called Vitiligo), his nose narrowed, and he spoke in a breathy, girlish voice. He often wore a germ mask while traveling, kept a pet chimpanzee named Bubbles as one of his closest companions, and surrounded himself with children at his Neverland Ranch, a storybook playland filled with toys, rides and animals. The tabloids dubbed him "Wacko Jacko."

Perhaps being thrust upon the stage and music industry at such a young age and with such an over-bearing father is the reason Michael created the Neverland Ranch. Michael never got a childhood like most people know. After years of performing to millions of adoring fans worldwide, it seems that Michael suffered from "The Peter Pan Syndrome". Except, he wasn't trying to remain a child, he was attempting to create the childhood which he never had. Jackson paved the way for countless musicians on many levels, from his writing, stage performance to his dancing. Alien Ant Farm recently did a remake of his song, "Smooth Criminal".

Despite all of Michael Jackson's contributions to the music industry and all of his humanitarian endeavors, including penning the lyrics for "We Are The World", it is rather unfortunate that the media has chosen to focus more on his bizarre behavior and troubled personal and legal life.

The media naturally notes Michael's extraordinary musical career, but has put a very negative spin on his afore mentioned bizarre behavior and troubled personal and legal life. They mention so many negative factors of his life, that it over-shadows his music.

They talk about how he caused a furor in 2002 when he dangled his infant son, Prince Michael II, over a hotel balcony in Berlin while a throng of fans watched from below.

alcohol and groping him, and of engaging in strange and inappropriate behavior with other children in 2003. They do make a brief side note that he was cleared of the charges he molested a 13-year-old cancer survivor at the Neverland Ranch in 2005.

The case followed years of rumors about Jackson and his relationships with young boys. In a TV documentary, he acknowledged sharing his bed with children, a practice he described as sweet and not at all sexual. Despite the acquittal, the lurid allegations that came out in court took a fearsome toll on his career and image, and he fell into serious financial trouble.

His peak may have come in 1983, when Motown celebrated its 25th anniversary with an all-star televised concert and Jackson moonwalked off with the show, joining his brothers for a medley of old hits and then leaving them behind with a pointing, crouching, high-kicking, splay-footed, crotch-grabbing run through "Billie Jean."

Jackson had strong follow-up albums with 1987's "Bad" and 1991's "Dangerous," but his career began to collapse in 1993 after the initial accusation he molested a boy who often stayed at his home. The singer denied any wrongdoing, reached a settlement with the boy's family, reported to be \$20 million, and criminal charges were never filed.

Jackson's 13 No. 1 one hits on the Billboard charts put him behind only Presley, the Beatles and Mariah Carey.

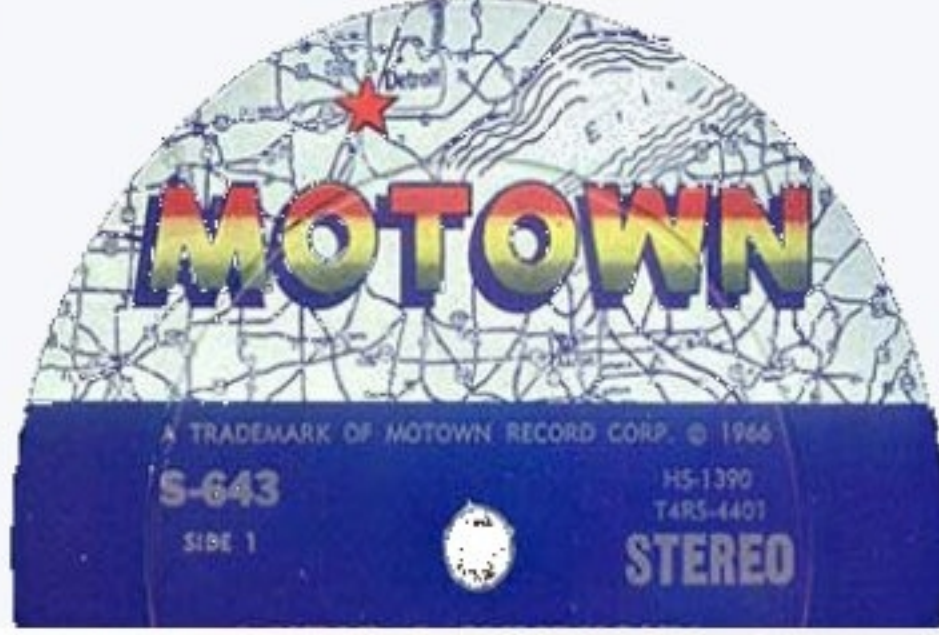

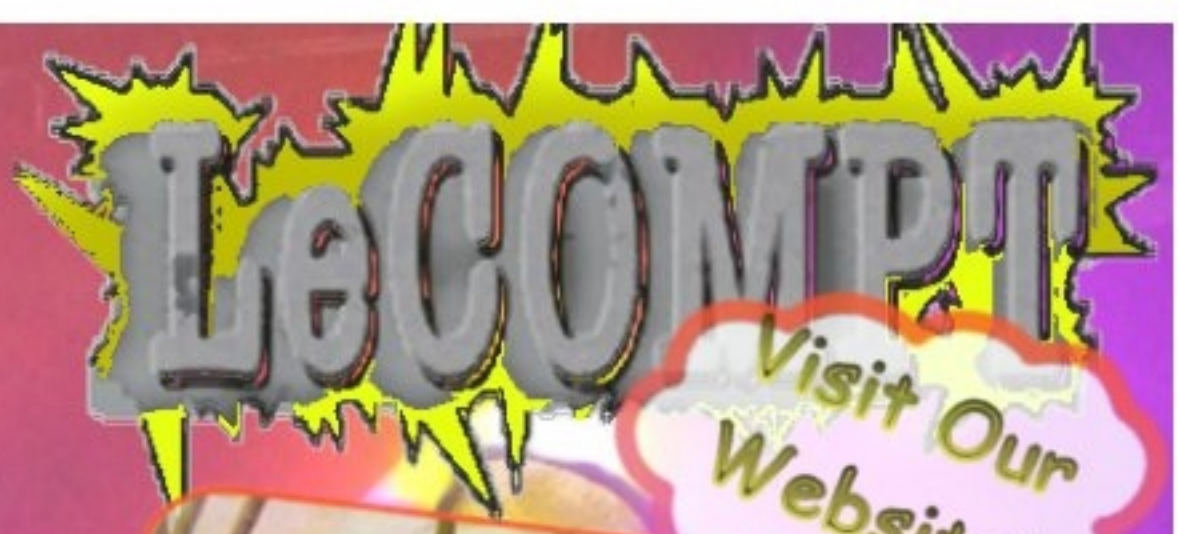

“STIMULATE THIS! TOUR”

STAIN D, SHINEDOWN, CHEVELLE & HALESTORM
DELIVER ROCK FANS THEIR OWN BAIL-OUT !!!
AUGUST 30th @ FESTIVAL PIER, PHILADELPHIA, PA !!!

Hard rock mavens Staind, Shinedown, Chevelle and Halestorm will be teaming up this Summer for the “Stimulate This!” tour, a four-band bill designed to offer fans maximum value at a minimal price and hits Festival Pier in Philadelphia, PA on 8/30/09! So what do you get when you put three multi-platinum recording artists and a new band soon to be a multi-platinum recording artist on the same bill? One hell of a Summer tour!

Making its way across the U.S. beginning July 1st and extending through early September, the “Stimulate This!” tour will hit more than 40 U.S. markets, including some of the hardest hit by the recession. In a show of solidarity for their fans, the four bands have worked closely with the concert promoters to create a package of exceptional value for ticket buyers. Through their collective efforts, they’ve been able to maintain modest base ticket prices that remain mostly under \$40 each - half the cost of comparable multi-band summer tour packages - with some venues offering lawn seats for less than \$10. Additionally, each tour stop will include special promotions for ticket holders that will vary from market to market, but could include discounts on concessions at the venue during the show, store discounts at local retailers, and online rebates for band merchandise to name a few!

“Wall Street got its bailout; now it’s time for rock fans to get theirs,” said Staind frontman Aaron Lewis. “This summer, we want to give our fans one night where they can forget about everything else and experience a great rock show.”

“We’ve always said that we, as a band, only answer to one boss...and that’s everyone in the audience,” according to Shinedown’s frontman, Brent Smith. “It’s our job...our privilege to offer our fans an escape. Teaming up with these other great bands, we’re doing what we can to help lift everyone’s spirits in these tough times...the power of music can do that.”

Staind, from Springfield, Massachusetts, have pumped out major hits like, “It’s Been Awhile”, “Outside”, “So Far Away” and “Fade”! Staind’s latest album, “The Illusion of Progress”, marks the band’s fourth consecutive studio album to debut in the top 3 on the Billboard 200 and features the #1 alternative rock song, “Believe.” The Atlantic recording group’s decade-long career is marked by more than 12 million in album sales worldwide and five #1 singles spanning three different radio formats. “The Illusion of Progress” is the band’s sixth studio album and the follow-up to their 2005 album, which has been certified platinum “Chapter V”. Staind recorded “The Illusion of Progress” in frontman Aaron Lewis’s home studio. Currently the third single from the album, “This Is It,” is climbing up the Active Rock radio chart.

Shinedown’s latest single, “Second Chance,” is proving to be a cross-over smash, earning the Jacksonville, Florida-based band its highest chart position yet on the pop charts, coming in at #11 this week and rising - the track has already gone to #1 at Active Rock and #2 at Alternative. The companion video for “Second Chance” has climbed to #4 on VH1’s Top 20 Countdown and also enjoys airplay on radio stations across the country. The title track from Shinedown’s current album, “The Sound Of Madness”, on Atlantic Records, recently stormed to #6 at Active Rock, continuing the band’s staggering run of 10 consecutive Top 10 hits at the format. “The Sound Of Madness” has been RIAA-certified Gold after debuting at #8 on the Billboard 200 upon release last summer. Not to mention their hit “Devour” off the album as well! There’s little doubt that Shinedown are among the most exciting new bands around! “The Sound Of Madness” follows the band’s platinum selling debut “Leave A Whisper” and gold-certified follow-up “Us And Them”, which produced hits like “Save Me,” “I Dare You,” and “Heroes”.

Chevelle have just wrapped up recording their highly-anticipated new album, “Sci-Fi Crimes”, which will hit stores later this summer. This new album, “Sci-Fi Crimes”, marks Chevelle’s fifth studio album and will follow up 2007’s smash “Vena Sera”. The Chicago-based band has remained a staple in the hard rock scene with six Top 5 Modern Rock hits under their belt, including the #1 songs “Send the Pain Below” and “Vitamin R (Leading Us Along)” as well as fan favorites, “The Red” and “The Clincher”.

Halestorm, from York, PA, just released their self-titled debut album on Atlantic Records. Halestorm is an explosive collection of infectious hard rock anthems, a fiery flurry of sexy hooks and rough and tumble grooves. Steering this runaway train is singer/guitarist Lzzy Hale, who brings a hypnotic intensity to such tracks as the sensual first single “I Get Off,” which is bulleting up the top 30 on the Active Rock radio chart.
