

WMGK 102.9, WMMR 93.3 & WYSP 94.1, along with every music station in the country is about to be hit with an unfair tax! In the midst of these hard economic times some members of congress are attempting to push through another tax on radio stations that play music.

The international record labels are asking Congress for a handout (H.R. 848 / S. 379) and they want to take it from local radio stations! Apparently, these big international record companies have a problem: they haven't adapted to the digital age. Now they are asking Congress to tax local radio stations to line their pockets and preserve a declining business – to the tune of billions of dollars!

The effects of a performance tax would be catastrophic, potentially forcing many radio stations out of business, causing additional job cuts in the radio industry, stifling airplay for artists, reducing the ability for radio stations to contribute to community organizations that rely on radio stations for support, and harming the listening public who depend on local radio right here in the Philadelphia tri-state area and across the country!

Jimmy Buffett's "Summerzcool 2009 Tour" By Michael Davis & Lisa Young


There aren't too many bands or musicians that not only have lucrative careers in the music industry, but longevity as well. The Rolling Stones, Aerosmith and KISS are among the few. Jimmy Buffett is one of the select lucky few to be in this category! But it is in no way luck! Jimmy is a talented musician and a true entrepreneur!

Buffett began his musical career in Nashville, Tennessee during the late 1960s as a country artist and recorded his first album, "Down To Earth" in 1970. During this time Buffett could be frequently found busking for tourists in New Orleans. Country music singer Jerry Jeff Walker took him to Key West, FL on a busking expedition. Buffett then moved to Key West and began establishing the easy-going beach bum persona for which he is known. Following this move, Buffett combined country, folk, and pop music with coastal as well as tropical lyrical themes for a sound sometimes called "gulf and western." His second album, "High Cumberland Jubilee" released in 1971 and his third album, "A White Sport Coat And A Pink Crustacean" released in 1973, didn't garner much notoriety. However, in 1974, his fourth album, "A1A" finally cracked the music scene and he hasn't looked back since! Every year Jimmy and The Coral Reefer Band play to sold out crowds from coast to coast and even in Vancouver, Toronto, Paris, London, Hong Kong and Perth, Australia, just to name a few locations.

With over 30 albums to his credit and multiple additional live albums, Jimmy Buffett has without a doubt inscribed himself within a very small group of musicians who can claim true longevity in the music industry! Jimmy's talents do not stop musically. He has written multiple best selling novels, started his own brand of Margaritaville tequillas, Margaritaville frozen foods and Margaritaville restaurants in the U.S. in Key West, Orlando, Panama Beach, Uncasville, New Orleans, Glendale, Las Vegas, Myrtle Beach and Hawaii, as well as, in the Caribbean in the Cayman Islands, Jamaica, Grand Turk, Cancun and Cozumel. Not to mention his new Landshark Lager, having Dolphin Stadium in Miami renamed, "Landshark Stadium" and all of his record and merchandising sales! Plus his Margaritaville themed casinos, Margaritaville Records, Mailboat Records, Cheeseburger in Paradise restaurants and multiple awards from the music industry!

His devoted fans call themselves Parrotheads and are a fun-loving, tropical bunch comprised of every demographic you can think of! Doctors, lawyers, IT gurus, dentists, authors, librarians, construction workers, garbage collectors, you name it and they are part of Jimmy's phlock! Jimmy appeals to just about everybody, no matter what age, color or religious denomination. Maybe it is because his songs are so easy to relate to for so many people. Musikfest 2009 Rocks Bethlehem, PA!!! By Michael Davis & Lisa Young

Musikfest 2009 is finally here! The annual festival runs from 7/31/09 through 8/9/09 in Bethlehem, PA!

The main stage, Sands River Place, hosts the big acts and this year's line-up is spectacular!

In 1984, nearly 182,000 people attended a small, grass-roots music festival in Bethlehem, Pa. featuring 118 performers and 295 performances on six stages. At the time, no one knew how large the event would grow or how long it would last.

Amazingly, more than two decades have passed since that first Musikfest. And from those humble beginnings, the event has blossomed into a 10-day musical spectacular that attracts more than one million people from throughout the country!

The festival, which showcases nearly every musical style imaginable, features: more than 300 performers from across the country and around the globe, musical programming at 14 different indoor and outdoor stages (11 stages are free), 10 great nights of headline entertainment, more mouth-watering foods than can be listed, plenty of children's fun and activities and a spectacular closing-night fireworks display.

Musikfest is open 5-11 p.m. July 31 and noon-11 p.m. Aug. 1-9. Alcohol vendors serve until 10:30 p.m., Food and Beverage Ticket booths are open until 10:45 p.m. and all other food and merchandise vendors are open until 11 p.m.

As a tribute to Bethlehem's Germanic heritage, Most of Musikfest's sites have german 'platz' names- the word 'platz' is German for "place."

Musikfest is presented by ArtsQuest, a community-focused nonprofit arts organization founded to "celebrate arts and culture" in the Lehigh Valley and beyond.

Proceeds from the event go to the Banana Factory, ArtsQuest's community arts center and gallery located in South Bethlehem, as well as other nonprofit groups in the region.

With the newly constructed Sands Casino in Bethlehem, it gives attendees just one more amazing place to visit and make reservations for accommodations! There are many other hotels in Bethlehem, PA near Musikfest, just Google "Bethlehem, PA Hotels"!






Chickenfoot Set To Rock The House Of Blues On 8/22/09 !!! By Michael Davis & Lisa Young

Chickenfoot is an American hard rock band, formed in 2008. The band is considered a supergroup as it features four established stars: vocalist Sammy Hagar (formerly of Van Halen and Montrose), bassist Michael Anthony (also ex-Van Halen), guitar virtuoso Joe Satriani and drummer Chad Smith (of the Red Hot Chili Peppers).-The band's name and logo are a reference to a disparaging term used to describe the peace symbol, the "footprint of the American chicken".

Chickenfoot completed its intimate initial "Road Test" tour of 9 cities, all which were SOLD OUT, ending on 5/29/09 at the Fillmore @ the TLA in Philadelphia, PA!!! The new supergroup are now preparing to embark on a full Summer 2009 tour!

Having just finished a run of festivals and a few solo dates in Europe, they are now back in the U.S. and gearing up for their assault of North America! Their first single from their selftitled debut album, "Oh Yeah" is getting airplay from coast to coast and abroad! As of today there is one local concert scheduled for 8/22/09 at the House Of Blues in Atlantic City, NJ! There are still a few tickets available, but will be gone very quickly as it is expected that the

Pearl Jam is scheduled to be the last act to ever play at the legendary, historic and beloved Spectrum in Philadelphia, PA on 10/27/09, 10/28/09, 10/30/09 and 10/31/09!

Construction of the arena occurred at a rapid pace so that the city's first National Hockey League franchise, the Philadelphia Flyers, could compete in the 1967-68 NHL season. Eleven months later, the Spectrum opened house for its first event ever, the Quaker City Jazz Festival. The two-day concert appeared from 9/30/67 to 10/1/67. Ed Snider, the original and done in record time." First night patrons fought huge traffic tie-ups going into the parking lots, delaying the jazz festival by fifty-five minutes.

The last of six main acts, which included Ramsey Lewis, Hugh Masakela and comedian Flip Wilson, did not finish until 3 a.m. The second performance drew a full house of 17,500 fans. It was the largest indoor audience in Philadelphia and Pennsylvania history. A 12-day run of Holiday on Ice followed. Boxing was the first sporting event at the young building, featuring a Joe Frazier vs. Tony Doyle card, on Tuesday, 10/17/67.

The next morning, the official dedication of the Spectrum took place under a canopy by the main entrance. The 76ers played their first game at the Spectrum that night, defeating the Los Angeles Lakers, 103-87. The Flyers debuted in their new home on Thursday, 10/19/67 with a 1-0 triumph over Pittsburgh.

It is hard to believe, but 42 years later in 2009, there now are plans to tear this beloved building down, as the Comcast-Spectacor sports complex boasts the Wachovia Center, Lincoln Financial Field and Citizens Bank Park. The "plan" is to tear down the Spectrum to make room for an entertainment complex in an effort to make the entire complex more lucrative and consumer friendly. The project, dubbed "Philly Live!" will include shops, bars and restaurants. The development will be located on the site of a parking lot that currently separates the Spectrum from the Wachovia Center, with preliminary plans showing a hotel where the Spectrum is currently located.

Lincoln Financial Field is the new home to the Philadelphia Eagles, but also has hosted

concerts from Bruce Springsteen and Kenny Chesney in 2008. Citizens Bank Park, the new home for the Philadelphia Phillies, just hosted The Police Reunion concert there last year, as well as, Jimmy Buffett.

New homes for the Eagles and Phillies, as Veterans Stadium, which had been home to both teams, from 1971 to 2003, was demolished on 3/21/04. The Spectrum was home to the Flyers and the 76ers from 1967 to 1996. Now the Flyers and 76ers play at the Wachovia Center.

The history of this landmark is staggering! The Spectrum went into operation in 1967, 9/30/67 to be exact, opening with the two-day Quaker City Jazz Festival. On 10/17/67, Joe Frazier boxed against Tony Doyle. The 20th Annual NBA All-Star Game was held on 1/20/70. The Flyers won 2 Stanley Cups in the Spectrum in 1974 and 1975. The Flyers played the Soviet Red Army on 1/11/76. The Spectrum hosted the 29th Annual NHL All-Star Game on 1/20/76 and the 26th Annual NBA All-Star Game on 2/3/76. Luciano Pavarotti sang there on 4/5/76. Elvis Presley sang there on 5/28/77. Bruce Springsteen had 8 sold out concerts there in 1981. The 76ers won the NBA Finals there, sweeping the Lakers in 1983. Frank Sinatra, Liza Minelli and Sammy Davis Jr. had a concert there on 9/27/88. Billy Joel sold out a 6 night engagement there in January of 1991. Luther Vandross had 3 sold out concerts in October of 1991. The 43rd Annual NHL All-Star Game was played there on 1/18/92. The Grateful Dead played their 50th concert there on 10/7/92. Billy Joel sold out another 6 night set of concerts in September and October of 1993. The Philadelphia Wings (Philly's lacrosse team in the NLL) won their 4th Championship there on 4/8/95. Mike Tyson boxed against Buster Mathis Jr. there on 12/16/95. The Philadelphia Phantoms (Philly's minor league hockey team) won the Calder Cup there on 6/10/98. Bruce Springsteen is scheduled to play the Spectrum on 10/13/09, 14/09, 10/19/09 and 10/20/09! Then Pearl Jam will be the final act playing there on 10/28/09 and 10/30/09! Pearl Jam will in effect be the band that officially says, "Goodbye" to this beloved and historic building.

Since 1967, the Wachovia Spectrum has held thousands of events. From NHL to NBA championships with the Flyers and 76ers, to Dorothy Hamill's first appearance with the Ice Capades and Elvis Presley's last live performance at the Spectrum. The building has hosted just about everything.

So, the Pearl Jam concerts will be the last piece of concert history for our beloved Spectrum! This legendary building, which holds so many fond memories for so many people, will soon be gone, just like Veterans Stadium, JFK Stadium (where Live Aid was held on July 13, 1985) and Connie Mack Stadium.

Many people hoped that the Spectrum would not have the same fate as these other stadiums, but when it does, at least we will always have our memories of all the great events that happened at the Spectrum!

In closing this article, which feels to be somewhat of a eulogy, here a few final words from Comcast-Spectacor chairman Ed Snider. "The Spectrum is my baby, but after a lot of thinking and discussions, we all feel it is in our best interest to close the Spectrum. It's something we've been reluctant to do, but at this point, I think the building has seen its best days, but, we'll have great memories from this building."

Stimulate This! Tour Hits Festival Pier!!! By Michael Davis & Lisa Young

Hard rock mavens Staind, Shinedown, Chevelle and Halestorm will be teaming up this Summer for the "Stimulate This!" tour, a four-band bill designed to offer fans maximum value at a minimal price and hits Festival Pier in Philadelphia, PA on 8/30/09! So what do you get when you put three multi-platinum recording artists and a new band soon to be a multi-platinum recording artist on the same bill? One hell of a Summer tour!

Making its way across the U.S. beginning July 1st and extending through early September, the "Stimulate This!" tour will hit more than 40 U.S. markets, including some of the hardest hit by the recession. 
Staind, from Springfield, Massachusetts, have pumped out major hits like, "It's Been Awhile", "Outside", "So Far Away" and "Fade"! Staind's latest album, "The Illusion of Progress", marks the band's fourth consecutive studio album to debut in the top 3 on the Billboard 200 and features the #1 alternative rock song, "Believe." The Atlantic recording group's decade-long career is marked by more than 12 million in album sales worldwide and five #1 singles spanning three different radio formats. "The Illusion of Progress" is the band's sixth studio album and the follow-up to their 2005 album, which has been certified platinum "Chapter V". Staind recorded "The Illusion of Progress" in frontman Aaron Lewis's home studio. Currently the third single from the album, "This Is It," is climbing up the Active Rock radio chart.

The title track from Shinedown's current album, "The Sound Of Madness", on Atlantic Records, recently stormed to #6 at Active Rock, continuing the band's staggering run of 10 consecutive Top 10 hits at the format. "The Sound Of Madness" has been RIAA-certified Gold after debuting at #8 on the Billboard 200 upon release last summer. Not to mention their hit "Devour" off the album as well! There's little doubt that Shinedown are among the most exciting new bands around! 'The Sound Of Madness" follows the band's platinum selling debut "Leave A Whisper" and gold-certified follow-up "Us And Them", which produced hits like "Save Me," "I Dare You," and "Heroes".

Chevelle have just wrapped up recording their highly-anticipated new album, "Sci-Fi Crimes", which will hit stores later this summer. 


